

Canning Stock Route - South



The longest historic stock route in the world, the Canning is regarded as one of the world's great four-wheel-drive journeys. This tour promises to be an adventure even for the most seasoned of modern-day explorers. For those that have enjoyed our original Canning Stock Route tour, this one ventures further south.



We travel from Alice Springs via the Tanami Desert to Kunawaratji. From there we head south, traversing the Little Sandy Desert, through some of Australia's most challenging and remote terrain.

We travel from Well 33 to Well 9, then onwards to Empress Spring before heading down into the Great Victoria Desert. From here we traverse roads built by Len Beadell east through the Unnamed Conservation Park, Emu Junction and Tallaringa Conservation Park. Exploranges is uniquely placed to escort you in comfort through this huge expanse of the Australian outback.



CANNING STOCK ROUTE - SOUTH: 21 Day Itinerary (Alice Springs to Adelaide)

- Day 1 We depart Alice Springs at 0730 and head west via the Tanami Track past Papunya and on to a bush camp on the Gary Junction Road.
- Day 2 Heading west through Kintore. Our camp will be at Jupiter Well.
- Day 3 Staying on the Gary Junction Highway, we head to Kunawaratji then on to Well 31.
- Day 4 Travelling south on the Canning Stock Route (CSR). Camp will be around Well 28 on the CSR.
- Day 5 Further down the CSR to Well 26.
- Day 6 Further down the CSR to Well 22.
- Day 7 Further down the CSR to Lake Disappointment.
- Day 8 Lake Disappointment to Well 18.
- Day 9 Further down the CSR to Durba Springs.
- Day 10 A day exploring the area at Durba Springs.
- Day 11 Durba Springs to Well 15.
- Day 12 Well 15 to Well 12
- Day 13 Well 12 to Well 9.
- Day 14 Well 9 to Carnegie Homestead.
- Day 15 Carnegie Homestead to Empress Spring.
- Day 16 Empress Spring to Tjikyurla.
- Day 17 We head past Lake Yeo out into the Great Victoria Desert.
- Day 18 Heading East on the Ann Beadell Highway.
- Day 19 Heading East on the Ann Beadell Highway.
- Day 20 Heading East on the Ann Beadell Highway into Coober Pedy.
- Day 21 Return to Adelaide arriving late*.

NB: This itinerary is approximate as desert travel can vary immensely depending on conditions.
